Vendor Information and Application Form

This year:

- We accept three vendor categories. Priority will be given to:
 - Craft vendors** selling items that are handmade. This can include arts and crafts, jewelry, clothing, household items, fine art, dolls and stuffed animals that are made by the seller. Craft vendors get first priority.
 - Vendors of manufactured and mass-produced items and commercial services** will be limited to **15 spaces**.
 - Non-profit organizations and community groups** will be limited to **15 spaces**.
 - Food vendors** can reserve booths as well. If selling food, you must be approved by the Hendricks County Health Department. **10 spaces** available. No alcohol allowed on property.
- Booth spaces are approximately 12' wide by 15' deep. ****Booths are non-transferable.**
- Political candidates or parties are not allowed to reserve spaces.
- One vehicle per booth space will be allowed. All others will need to park in the designated parking areas.
- **Upon check-in, one parking permit will be given.** This is to go on the dashboard so that it is visible. Any vehicle parked in the vendor area without a parking voucher will be asked to move their vehicle. We only have limited space. This is for safety reasons for all persons.
- **Parking spaces in the designated parking areas CAN NOT be saved.**
- Vendors will be assigned spaces by Plainfield Friends. Indicate a preferred location on the map included with the application. We will try to place you there but cannot guarantee a specific spot.
- Vendors must supply their own tables and chairs. Electricity is available on part of the grounds. (minimum 100' extension cord recommended)
- We reserve the right to refuse any vendor whose product or presentation conflicts with our values and beliefs.
- The festival will be held rain or shine. **No Refunds.**
- The cost of each booth space is **\$50.00** if registered by August 31, 2026.
- Registration after August 31, 2026 will be **\$55.00**.
- Electrical hook-ups cost an additional **\$5.00**.

*****Please send the application form with your payment to: If payment is not included, a booth space will not be assigned. Payments and applications WILL NOT be accepted on day of the festival.**
